

#### Overview:

The *Jackson T. Stephens Scholarship* awards participants who excel in academics, leadership, character development, and chapter and community involvement. Thanks to the generous donors of our 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration, First Tee-Central Arkansas is proud to offer a \$5,000 scholarship provided to one young lady and one young man to help with cost of their college education.

## **Participant Selection:**

Applications are accepted once per year from seniors in high school who meet the minimum eligibility requirements. All components of the application will be reviewed with consideration that this scholarship is a need and merit-based scholarship.

Following the closing date of March 29, 2024, a judging committee will review the submissions and identify two individuals to receive a one time \$5,000 Jackson T. Stephens Scholarship. The selections will be announced by April 30, 2024.

## **Eligibility Requirements:**

To be eligible for the Jackson T. Stephens Scholarship, applicants must meet ALL of the following requirements:

- Must be classified as a high school senior as of December 31, 2023
- Minimum 2.75 GPA on a 4.0 grading scale
- Intend to attend a four-year accredited college or university in Fall 2024
- Involved in chapter activities at the time of application submission
  - Participants who have spent a longer amount of time in First Tee programs will receive higher consideration in the selection.
- Evidence of responsible volunteerism or citizenship through meaningful involvement in community and/or civic activities
